The regulations under New Brunswick's *Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Act* reference 40 CSA standards, standards that, if applied, make our workplaces safer. Did you know that read-only access to these standards, as well as those referenced in the legislation of other Canadian jurisdictions, is available online through the CSA website?

To view the CSA standards go to ohsviewaccess.csa.ca and register (it's free). Then select the name of the jurisdiction from the drop-down menu, and select the standard you want to view. You will not be able to cut and paste, print or download the standard—this can only be done once purchased.
